7. Granbazán Etiqueta Verde Albariño, Rías Baixas, Spain, 13% <i>Straw yellow in colour with green tones. Clean and brilliant. The nose shows a medium-high intensity: citrus, grapefruit, lime, kiwi, white flowers with a balsamic background. Fresh mouth with fine bubbles, fruity with a good intensity, slightly oily and balanced.</i>				£28.95
